# International Conference on Animal Science AND Veterinary Medicine (ICAVET) Paper Competition

### I. Background

The COVID-19 pandemic has hit various parts of the world. Indonesia, being a large nation that inhabits land and oceans, it can be ascertained that there are many problems, needs and challenges facing country, especially in the field of animal health and its production. Some can overcome in the short term, but many of the problems, obstacles and new needs will be resolved at a later. Student must help find the right solution. Whether in the form of short-term action or realistic thinking that takes a long time. This competition opens opportunities for students to express creative realistic ideas as an intellectual response to actual problems facing the nation. The idea is independent from the field of science, unique creative realistic, visionary / futuristic and useful.

### II. This event aims to:

- Motivate students to deliver their aspirations and idea of current global scientific issues
- Encourage students to create scientific innovations and changes to solve environmental issues
   nearby through scientific project abstract writing
- Facilitate students to experience and involved in both national and international scientific
   forum through scientific writing competition

### III. Themes and Scopes

The theme raised in this scientific writing competition is "Innovation on Animal Health and Animal Production in the Pandemic of COVID-19".

The scope of discussion can cover all aspects of the state such as social, economic, cultural, political, legal, education, health, defense and security, technology, food and the environment.

Determination of issues must be original, actual and refers to solve problems that occur in society today and requires long-term sustainable solutions based on the results of smart thinking.

The output is creative ideas in the form of scientific articles containing the concept of change

### V. Schedule and Registration

### VI. Criteria and Submission of Manuscripts

The Requirements and procedures for submission are as follows

- a. Participants must follow the rules issued and formally prepared by the International Conference on Animal Science and Veterinary Science Paper Competition Committee.
- b. The Participants are student from Veterinary Medicine, Animal science, DVM Program, Fisheries and Marine Science, all universities around the world.
- c. Students are required to upload a valid Student Identity Card
- d. University can send more than 1 (one) team and each team only sends 1 (one) paper.
- e. Each group consists of 3-5 students

- f. Member in one team can be multidisciplinary in the same university or across universities
- g. Each group appoints one participant to be the group leader.
- h. All members are written in fullname
- i. The number of pages allowed for each proposal is a maximum 15 pages (CHAPTER I to CHAPTER III), excluding attachments and bibliography
- j. Proposals are saved in one PDF format file and named according to the following format: papercompetition\_fkhub\_ (first author)
- k. The maximum file size is 5 MB
- I. The file is then uploaded to the website <a href="http://icoh.fkh.ub.ac.id/icavet">http://icoh.fkh.ub.ac.id/icavet</a>
- m. The committee has right to cancel the participation / winnings of participants if fraud and plagiarism is found

### VII. Writing systematics

- a. Writing papers using Times New Roman font size 12, spacing 1.15 spaces
- b. A4 paper size with 4 cm left margin, 3 cm each for right, top, and bottom margins.
- c. The cover page to the Attachment pages are given pages with numerals: 1, 2, 3, ... etc. which are placed in the upper right corner. The page number is not written in cover

### Format:

- 1. Cover (Attachment 2)
- 2. Validation sheet (Attachment 3)
- 3. Table of contents
- 4. Chapter I. Introduction

The Introduction describes the background that reveals the situation and condition of the nation, the state which is the reason for raising the idea to become a scientific paper (equipped with supporting data or information). This section also reveals the goals and the amount of benefits to be achieved.

### Chapter II. Idea

- a. Current conditions for initiating ideas (obtained from reading material, interviews / discussions, observation, relevant imagination)
- b. Solutions that have been implemented to improve the conditions of originators
- c. The conditions of the initiator of ideas can be updated or developed through scientific writing if the idea is implemented

- d. The stakeholders under consideration can help implement the idea and their respective roles or contributions
- e. Strategic steps that must be taken to implement
- f. Ideas to expect goals or updates that can be achieved.

### 3. Chapter III. Conclusion

The conclusion is the final part of the article that takes the reader out of the discussion. In general, the conclusions reveal the ideas proposed by the implementation techniques that will be carried out, and the prediction of the results that will be obtained (benefits and impacts of the ideas).

### 4. Bibliography

Bibliography that is referenced in the manuscript, is written in Harvard style.

### VIII. Proposal Selection and Evaluation

Selection and evaluation are carried out online by the Scientific Committee Team of FKH UB. The content must be following requirements:

- a. Creative and objective: writing contains creative ideas that offer solutions to problems, needs or challenges facing society.
- b. Writing is supported by reliable data and / or information, original (not plagiarism).
- c. Logical and Systematic: each writing step is designed systematically and coherently, and contains elements of problem identification, synthesis analysis, conclusions.
- d. The contents of the writing are based on literature review or other information sources
- e. This opportunity is given to students who have creative ideas and are able to put them in writing, even though they are not studying formally in that field.
- f. Written material is an actual issue.

### IX. Assessment criteria

- The proposal selection will be carried out by the Scientific committee of FKH UB. The value of the proposal will then be ranked according to the criteria points that we have set (Attachment 7).
- 2. Top Five finalists will be asked to submit a PPT file with a predetermined format which can be downloaded on the website <a href="http://icoh.fkh.ub.ac.id/icavet">http://icoh.fkh.ub.ac.id/icavet</a>
- 3. Top Five proposals have opportunity to present their ideas at the conference
- 4. The winner assessment:

Total score = (50% x Article score) + (50% x Presentation score)




